PRAGATI SCHEME

This scheme is for Meritorious Girl Students. It was started in the year 2014 to award scholarship of upto Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study to meritorious girl students to encourage them to pursue technical education at the degree and diploma level in AICTE approved institutions. More than 14,000 girl students were benefited under the scheme between 2014-2019. In the year 2020-21, AICTE has enhanced the number of scholarships from 4000 to 10,000.

This scheme was started in the year 2014 to award scholarship of upto Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study to specially abled students to encourage them to pursue technical education at the degree and diploma level in AICTE approved institutions. Prime Ministers Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS)

PMSSS facilitates students of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh to pursue higher education. Under the scheme, AICTE provides annual scholarship towards academic fee & maintenance allowance. Each year 5000 students are awarded these scholarships to pursue programmes in General Stream, Medical, Engineering or other professional subjects.

Visvesvaraya Best Teachers Award

The award is meant for identifying the extraordinary teachers and recognize the excellence / best practices / innovations of such teachers in the field of technical education at National level for Degree and Diploma institutions. Every year on 5th Sept, 20 such identified teachers are awarded at National level.

Research Promotion Scheme (RPS)

The scheme promotes research in identified thrust areas of Technical education. RPS is aimed at creating research ambience in the institutes by promoting research in engineering sciences and innovations in established and newer technologies in AICTE approved institutions.

AICTE DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP (ADF)

This scheme was started in the year 2018 to award fellowship of Rs 31,000 per month in the first two years and Rs 35,000 per month in next two years to the full-time meritorious students pursuing Ph.D. program. The aim is nurture talents & promote collaborative research between Institute & Industries leading to start-ups. In the year 2020-21 this scheme is extended to 39 universities across different states of India with the mandate to admit 339 research scholars under it.

Major expenses for travel & honorarium under the initiative is borne by AICTE.

It was felt that training with latest tools and technologies is vital to keep an institute, faculty and students competitive & more productive. Training is required for increasing the knowledge and skills of students to make them more employable to acquire global competencies. Therefore, AICTE through its newly announced AICTE Training And Learning (ATAL) Academy started unique faculty development programs (FDP) in various emerging areas. 1000 such online FDP has been planned in the year 2020-21.

AICTE- IDEA LAB

AICTE is establishing IDEA (Idea Development, Evaluation & Application) Labs as co-developed and co-funded entities in the colleges in its folds. The aim is to make engineering graduates more curious, imaginative and creative, besides training them in 21st century skills like problem solving, critical thinking, collaboration and communication. To be managed by the students, a 24x7 IDEA Lab placed as common facility in the college will allow users to “engage, explore, experience, express and excel”

AICTE-Campus Accommodation & Facilities Enhancing Social (CAPES)

It is operated to fund construction of hostels (or expansion of existing hostels) in government/ government-aided institutions. The objective is to facilitate continuation of studies beyond college hours and all round development of the students. There are three variants of the Scheme catering to the accommodation needs of students belonging to categories of (a) SC&ST (b) Differently-abled and (c) North-East Region. Financial support upto Rs 3.25 crore is given for the construction, to be completed within 3 years.

LOK SABHA ON 15TH DECEMBER, 1987)

(ASSENTED BY THE PRESIDENT ON 23RD DECEMBER, 1987)

An Act

To provide for the establishment of an All India Council for Technical Education with a view to the proper planning and co-ordinated development of the technical education system through out the country, the promotion of qualitative improvements of such education in relation to planned quantitative growth and the regulation and proper maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education system and for matters connected therewith.
